### IMPORTANT DATES

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### CONCERT TICKETS

- June Concert Ticket pre-sales will be May 10th-11th at the Topeka Performing Arts Center Box Office only. Box office hours are 11am-2pm and 4pm-6pm each of those days. This is to help anyone who is interested in purchasing tickets without TICKETMASTER service fees.
- Please note that if you choose to purchase tickets on the first two days, you will likely have to wait in line. The TPAC Box Office is a locally owned and operated business and can only accommodate two ticket transactions at a time. There are plenty of tickets and wonderfully placed seats for everyone! We thank you in advance for your patience with TPAC.
- Ticket sales will then be available online and in the box office starting on Friday, May 12th at 10am. TICKETMASTER service fees will apply when purchasing tickets online
- Ticket prices will be as follows: \$6, \$8, \$10, \$15 (*this is the price before TICKETMASTER fees if purchased online*) Ticket prices are based on seat placement. All sections of TPAC will be open. There are ticketed seats on the floor and in the balcony.
- Everyone entering the auditorium will be required to present a ticket to enter. Children, ages three and under, will be admitted for free but **MUST** sit in a lap. If you would like a seat for your child aged three and under, you will be required to purchase a ticket.
- Dancers participating in our June Concert do not need a ticket.

## HAIR / MAKEUP / SHOES / TIGHTS

- **HAIR**

- 3 Year Old-2nd grade dancers need to have their hair pulled half-up and we would prefer curly!
- 3rd Grade-High School dancers will be wearing their hair in a low ponytail, with a middle part
- Company dancers - please follow your competition hairstyle guidelines

- **MAKE-UP**

- Dancers are not required to purchase a certain brand of make-up or specific colors. Dancers not wearing enough make-up will look washed out beneath the bright stage lights!
  - Foundation or powder to match the dancers skintone
  - Light and dark brown eyeshadows on eyelids
  - Blush
  - Black eyeliner
  - Black mascara
  - Dark Red Lipstick
  - False Eyelashes - OPTIONAL - highly recommended on stage
  - Company dancers - please follow your competition makeup guidelines

- Dancers need to wear all black dance attire, correct shoes and competition hair completely slicked back.
- There will be a designated area, downstairs, for dancers to eat their dinner. Please do not bring food into the TPAC auditorium.

## IMPORTANT SHOW DAY DETAILS - PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

- Dancers must be in their dressing room 45 minutes prior to show time. PLEASE BE ON TIME!
- Costume cover-ups must be worn to and from the performance venue.
- There are no visitors allowed backstage or in the dressing rooms during the show, with the exception of one parent/guardian per dancer. There will be helpers assigned to each dressing room to help the dancers get to and from the stage and to keep them safe throughout the show so you can enjoy the performance!
- Dancers are expected to remain in their dressing room throughout the entire show. We will have a finale at the end of the show!
- We do NOT allow dancers to be roaming the hallways or the auditorium prior to showtime or during intermission.
- We encourage parents to send activities to help keep their child occupied - card games, iPad, dvd player, etc. Please no markers, paint or anything that will stain costumes.
- Dancers may bring a bottle of water with them to the dressing room, but no other food or other drink is allowed. Any food or drink brought in other than water will be immediately disposed of.
- The dancers will be directed back to their assigned dressing rooms after the finale. Please make arrangements to pick up your dancer in the dressing room after the performance.

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## SOLO/DUO/TRIO SHOWCASE - SATURDAY, JUNE 10TH – APPROXIMATELY 3:30 PM

- All of our solos, duos and trios will get one last chance to perform their extra dances for friends and family this season. This is a very laid back showcase without lighting cues and set changes - but so fun!!
